GOD IS WAITING FOR YOUR INVITATION

I love to talk to people. That's important for my job, but it can also be troublesome.

My daughter follows a similar path, speaking easily with just about anyone. The first day we dropped her off for college, she met her new roommate and the two of them stayed up until 4 a.m., talking and learning all about each other.

That's how we learn about God, too. Opening our hearts and spending time in conversation. God is speaking to us all the time, in so many ways – through scripture, through other people, through nature, and most of all, through prayer.

When it comes to prayer, however, I wasn't always so chatty with God. (Maybe I was too busy talking to everyone else).

It has taken some time, and some discipline, to realize that prayer is what really connects us to God. Prayer is the way you "allow God to touch your life," says William M. Watson, S.J.

Fr. Watson wrote a book on prayer called "Inviting God into Your Life." I

like that title because it pinpoints what was missing previously in my prayer life – the invite. Sometimes, we're afraid to invite God in. Maybe our house is too messy right now. Maybe we're not home too much and it's not convenient for us right now.

But God is waiting for our invitation. He doesn't care if the conditions aren't right, or we don't have the right words. God wants to help you with that. By showing up, giving God some regular daily time, you will notice how much easier and fulfilling this prayer time will become.

I've had the joy in the past couple of years of serving as a prayer companion for undergrads, grad students, and young professionals in our Busy Person Retreat. Participants commit to praying daily, then meet with a companion each week to talk about how that experience went. The students I met with were inspirational to me.

They discovered that connecting daily with God made their hectic lives more productive and helped to ease the stress. They often felt a sense of peace in knowing that they're not alone and that God is someone who can help us to bear our burdens.

If you weren't able to sign up for the daily prayer retreat this Lent, you can still make a promise to develop a more consistent prayer life. Start by setting aside some regular time each day. Perhaps read some scripture, maybe a few psalms. Read the chosen

passage over a couple of times and try to see if something stands out.

Above all, trust that God will meet you where you are, and will help you with your desire to pray. In fact, God is pleased with your effort. Invite God into your life. It will be a nice visit.

"It is Jesus that you seek when you dream of happiness; he is waiting for you when nothing else you find satisfies you.... It is he who reads in your heart your most genuine choices, the choices that others try to stifle." (Saint Pope John Paul II)

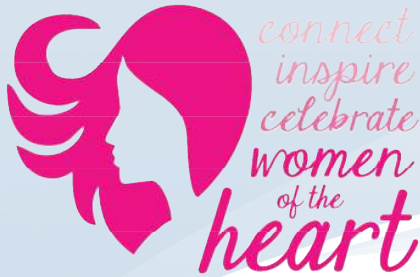

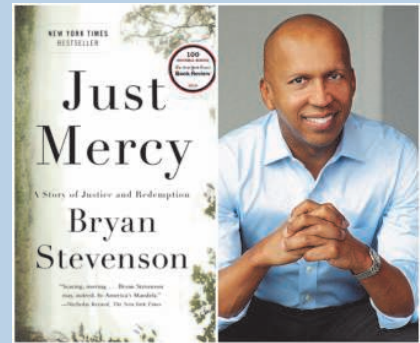
Responding to Injustice:

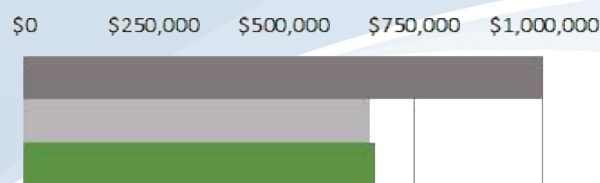

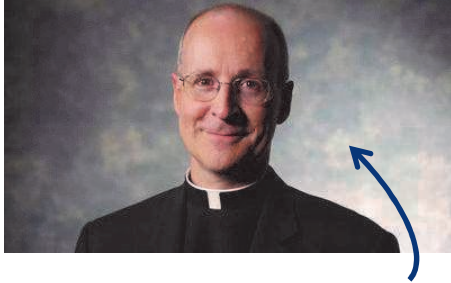
