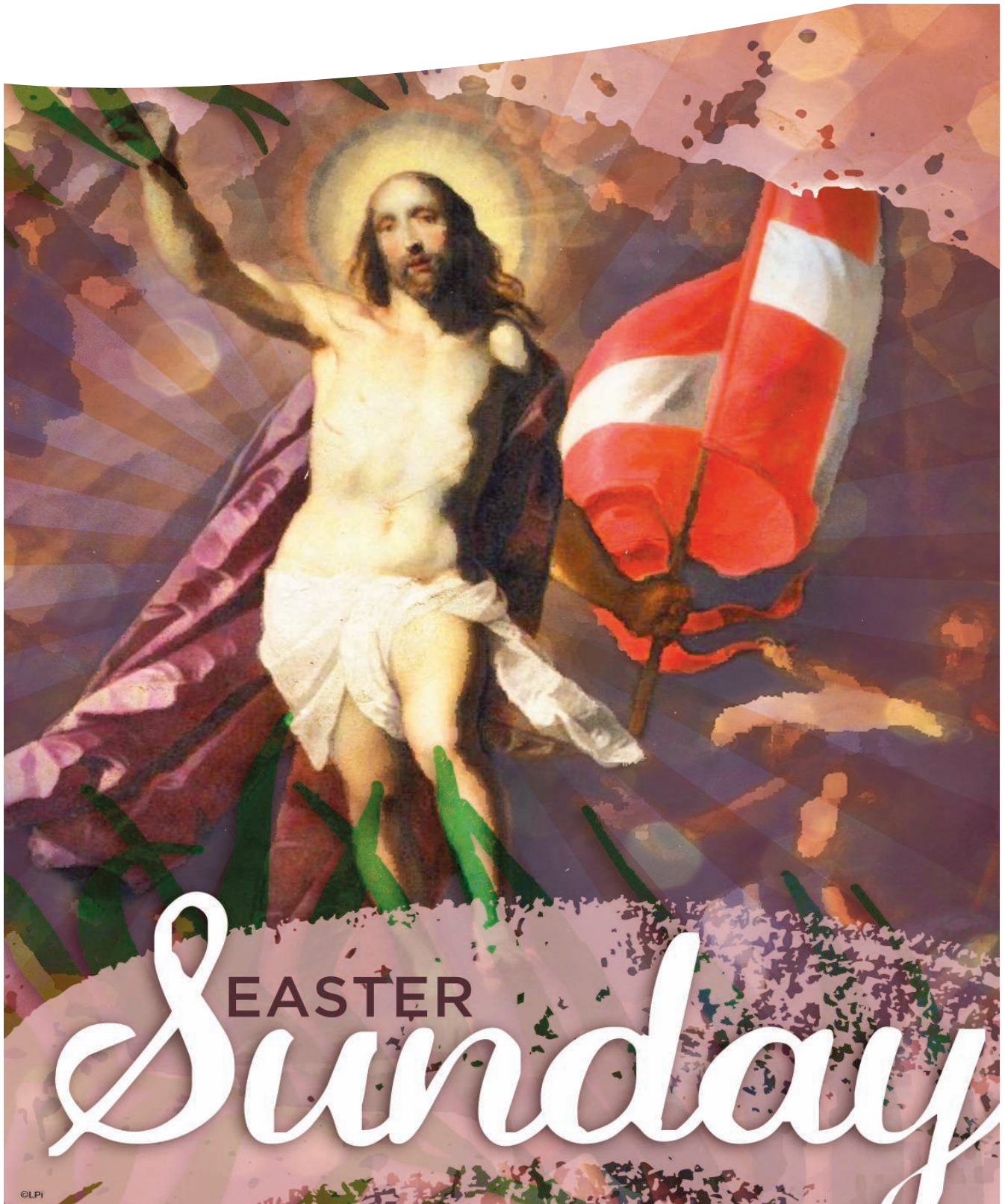

EASTER SACRAMENTS BRING RENEWAL by Rita Zyber, RCIA & Confirmation Coordinator

“Jesus Christ loves you; he gave his life to save you; and now he is living at your side every day to enlighten, strengthen and free you.” (Pope Francis, Evangelii gaudium, 164)

Easter is about new life and renewal. At this parish, and all around the world, the Church received some important gifts last night, and some pretty clear signs of renewal. At our Easter Vigil liturgy last night, we welcomed five people who were baptized into Christ through the Catholic Church.

We also welcomed and confirmed 10 others. This enthusiastic group of new Catholics is truly a gift to the Church. All year, they have learned and prayed and witnessed God at work in their lives. Now, equipped with new friendship in Christ, and empowered by the Holy Spirit, they are ready to set the world on fire.

Are we ready to do the same?

Bishop Robert Barron writes that the Church and its people cannot be separated from Christ.

“The Church is a sacrament of Jesus and as such, shares in the very being, life and energy of Christ.”

So those who joined the Church this weekend may have started out with the intention of joining a human institution. While that’s true, Bishop Barron says to them, “you are most definitely joining your life and being with that of Jesus Christ. “I am the vine, you are branches.”

CENTERING PRAYER

Mondays | 6:30 PM

Centering Prayer is a silent practice of prayer that rests on the faith that Christ is present within by his Holy Spirit. It is an excellent preparation for contemplative prayer, which is a grace or gift bestowed by God. Centering Prayer is an intentional openness to, or practice of "waiting" on God, encouraging the building of a more intimate relationship with Jesus and the movement of the Holy Spirit. It is rooted in centuries-old monastic prayer. The book Open Heart, Open Mind by Fr. Thomas Keating, OCSO is a good introduction. The first Monday of each month we listen to an introduction to centering prayer and then pray for 20 minutes. Otherwise, we typically sit and pray for two 20-minute sessions with a short meditative walk in between. All are welcome.
