

The organization was founded out of the events of El Salvador's Civil War, during which Archbishop Oscar Romero, Rutillio Grande, the Jesuit Martyrs, and thousands of others were killed by the Salvadoran military. The effects of this conflict still radiate through the country and throughout



the United States, as many who fled conflict and disaster in El Salvador are now in danger of losing their Temporary Protection Status (TPS). CRISPAZ has hosted several delegations from

St. Mary Student Parish as part of the Alternative Spring Break Program. Join us as Francisco shares reflections on CRISPAZ's work in El Salvador, rooted in peace, solidarity, and faith.








## **MONDAY NIGHT BAPTISM CLASS**


