AND BEHOLD - A SENIOR GIFT REFLECTION by Claire Jilek, Class of '2018

<u>And behold</u>, there was a great earthquake, for an angel of the Lord descended from heaven and came and rolled back the stone and sat on it.

...Then go quickly and tell his disciples that he has risen from the dead, and behold, he is going before you to Galilee; there you will see him. See, I have told you."

...And behold, Jesus met them and said, "Greetings!" And they came up and took hold of his feet and worshiped him. Then Jesus said to them, "Do not be afraid; go and tell my brothers to go to Galilee, and there they will see me."

...And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age.

—Matthew 28

A few Saturdays ago, I attended the Senior Day of Reflection at St. Mary. Brisk, April winds cut through the air - but the sun was shining as I walked to Newman Hall that morning unaware of what the day may hold. We began in prayer, through Lectio

Divina. This prayer starts with reading a passage from scripture once through, listening and absorbing the Word of God, and maybe noticing any words or phrases that seem to stand out. Then, the scripture is read again so as to hear how one's phrase fits in the passage or to understand the reading with fuller meaning. The passage can be read as many times as one chooses to deepen awareness of what God is revealing to us through prayer. That Saturday, we read Matthew 28. No particular word or phrase stuck out to me the first time the passage was read. Then, I began to hear "and behold" repeat throughout Matthew's words. They struck me, but I did not know what these words meant to me and to my own faith.

When we were encouraged to create a canvas incorporating our phrases, I painted "and behold." It was not until a few days later, as I examined the blue canvas hanging on my wall, that I realized what these words meant to me. God was reminding me to see, to gaze upon, to remember, to behold the meaning that St. Mary has given to me throughout my four years of my undergraduate career. St Mary has been my rock, and it has been my community. It has grown my faith, it has taught me hope, and it has showed me love and charity. God has blessed me with this endlessly giving community and parish, for which I am ever grateful.

This Sunday, I am making a gift—my Senior Gift to St. Mary—in honor of all that this parish family has given to me.

I give so that all students at St. Mary who come after me will continue to feel the same lasting impact this parish has had on me. I give because every dollar matters, and every dollar can help another student, another visitor at the warming shelter, another Alternative Spring Break mission, or another Ig.nite meal. I give because I know the impact that one dollar can have. I give because I have seen the good this parish has done for our Ann Arbor community, for other members of our parish, and for me.

I invite you to reflect upon what St. Mary means to you. If giving back to the parish is a desire, I encourage you to start donating today- even as a student!

And to my fellow graduating members of the SMSP community: congratulations on your many accomplishments throughout these years. Know that St. Mary will always be there for you, wherever your journey takes you.
