MY LIGHT AND MY SALVATION *by Ali Quinn, Campus Minister*



In my life, Jesus has always been the accessible part of the Trinitarian God.

When I was little, my

mom used to send me and my 4 brothers and sisters to various Vacation Bible Schools at different churches during the summer because it was the easiest (and cheapest) way to get us out of the house. We would sing songs like the classic “Jesus loves me this I know.”

My entire elementary catechesis was leading to receiving Jesus in the Eucharist at First Communion. After second grade, we spent a lot of our time learning about his life in the Gospels. I was told that Jesus is my friend and he will never leave me. Which is why, the Ascension, at times, was hard for me to grasp.

Jesus rose from the dead...
Wasn't that good enough?
Why did he have to leave us again?

These two weeks, we hear about the Ascension of the Lord and the coming of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost.

The Ascension celebrates Christ's triumphant victory over death. He did not just die and rise, he ascended

into heaven. He made heaven open to us.

God didn't leave us then. He sent us the Holy Spirit.

We hear at Pentecost that Christ will send the Holy Spirit to guide us if only we learn to trust in him.

Jesus was always easy for me to grasp. He is a person, who lived and breathed. He was a person who walked among us. My life, especially since Confirmation, has been a process of learning to trust that the Holy Spirit is with me, guiding me.

This was my first year at St. Mary Student Parish. Last July, I moved across the country to Ann Arbor. As a two-time Notre Dame graduate, you can imagine it was hard for me to trust why God was leading me here.

This year I've witnessed the beauty of God's work. I walked with students as they asked questions of life and God, learning to navigate life in college. I saw over 200 students come together for mass and a meal on Thursdays at Ig.nite and grow together in community. I watched almost 100 students go on ASB and come back with a new understanding of love and service. When our parish came together in January to open the doors to those experiencing homelessness in the Ann Arbor community, I felt God's presence among us.

At Pentecost, the Holy Spirit descended on the disciples as if tongues of fire, giving them peace and a mission. I pray that we all learn to trust in the Holy Spirit's work in our lives, allowing him to fill us with his peace and guide our every step.

There's another song that we should remember, “this little light of mine, I'm going to let it shine.” The light of the Holy Spirit is in each of us, let us not be afraid to let it shine.

BISHOP'S DIVERSITY LISTENING TASK FORCE

WED, MAY 23 | 5 PM

Bishop Earl Boyea announced the formation of a Diocesan Task Force on Race and Catholic Schools on March 13 in a prayer service and commissioning at St Thomas Aquinas Church, East Lansing.

The task force is a racially and ethnically diverse group comprising appointees from around the diocese that will listen to Diocese of Lansing Catholic school, parish and community constituencies.

Their role specifically is to listen to people of color; recommend ideas to better understand and serve the needs of racial and ethnic minorities in our Catholic schools; and make recommendations to the bishop about how to best accompany all people in our Catholic school communities toward a closer relationship with God, who desires each one of us to be one with him in heaven.

The task force will be charged with holding some listening sessions to hear from a variety of voices from all parts of the diocese and to develop and deliver to Bishop Boyea a set of recommendations in accordance with Catholic social teaching about how Diocese of Lansing Catholic Schools can better listen to and accompany our racial and ethnic minorities. Those recommendations are expected to be sent to the bishop for his consideration by the Fall of 2018.

St. Mary will host a listening session on Wednesday, May 23 at 5:00 p.m.

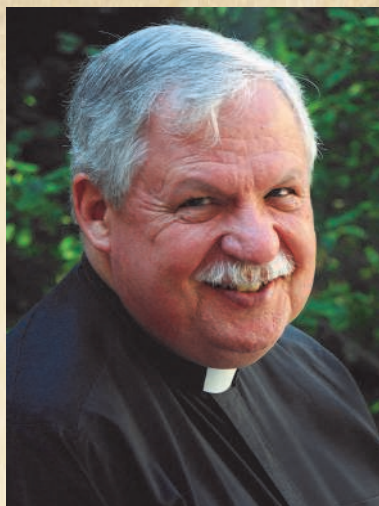

MONDAYS | 6:30 PM

Centering Prayer is a silent practice of prayer that rests on the faith that Christ is present within by his Holy Spirit. It is an excellent preparation for contemplative prayer, which is a grace or gift bestowed by God.

Centering Prayer is an intentional openness to, or practice of "waiting" on God, encouraging the building of a more intimate relationship with Jesus and the movement of the Holy Spirit. It is rooted in centuries-old monastic prayer. The book "Open Heart, Open Mind" by Fr. Thomas Keating, OCSO is a good introduction. The first Monday of each month we listen to an introduction to centering prayer and then pray for 20 minutes. Otherwise, we typically sit and pray for two 20-minute sessions with a short meditative walk in between. All are welcome.

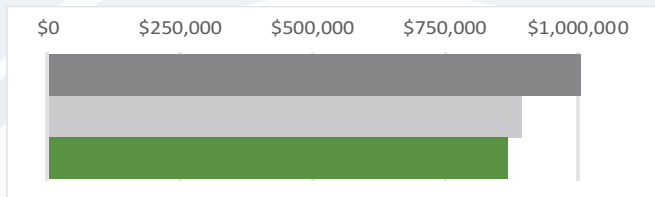

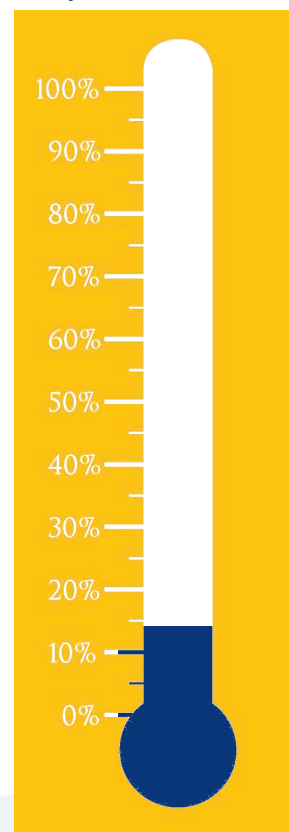
