## PEOPLE ON THE MOVE by Jake Derry, Campus Ministry Associate



This being my last full week as Campus Ministry Associate at St. Mary, it's fitting for this Sunday's Gospel reading

(May 27) to be "The Great Commission." I see a parallel between Jesus sending out his disciples saying, "Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations," and him sending me out from St. Mary, this place that has literally and figuratively been a home.

Jesus gives this call to the disciples on a mountaintop. It's also on a mountaintop where they saw Jesus transfigured and where they heard him deliver the Sermon on the Mount. The mountaintop, then, was a key location for the formation and spiritual feeding of the disciples.

Over the prior four years as a student and then this past year as a staff member, St. Mary has been the primary venue where Jesus has formed and fed me - walking with me, teaching me through the Gospels and through others, and showing me the Father's grace and mercy. Now, like the disciples, I enter a time of transition.

If we place ourselves as one of the disciples in the reading, how do we

handle this transition, this sending out? Do we doubt or resist, thinking this is too big of a task for just eleven people? Do we feel unqualified or unworthy, questioning whether we belong among this group of disciples?

Then, let our hearts be opened and comforted by the last thing Jesus says to the disciples in Matthew's Gospel, "And behold, I am with you always, until the end of the age." Jesus is with us...wait, it gets better though. God is with us, and...the Holy Spirit is with us. Three divine persons. All coming together as one God to work with us and for us. How beautiful.

Now, anytime I face transition, I will be reminded of the constant presence of the Holy Trinity. I will be reminded that making disciples of all nations requires transition; it requires us to be people on the move. I will be reminded that God's plans are better than my plans and also of Pope Francis when he wrote, "The joy of the Gospel is such that it cannot be taken away from us by anyone or anything (cf Jn 16:22)."

Hearing all this, I feel ready to respond to Jesus' call to "make disciples of all nations" in whatever form that takes in my life. How about you? Are you ready?

If you're still grappling with it, here's one more piece of encouragement - a

quote from Bob Goff: "Sometimes we get the impression that if we go across the ocean, it's more noble than going across the street. And I think...all of Heaven is leaning over the rails hoping we'll go across the room, the campus, the street to someone who hasn't been that easy to love, and that we'll express love without agenda because we want to grow in the faith."

So, where are you moving? What's your next step?

Centering Prayer is a silent practice of prayer that rests on the faith that Christ is present within by his Holy Spirit. It is an excellent preparation for contemplative prayer, which is a grace or gift bestowed by God.

Centering Prayer is an intentional openness to, or practice of "waiting" on God, encouraging the building of a more intimate relationship with Jesus and the movement of the Holy Spirit. It is rooted in centuries-old monastic prayer. The book "Open Heart, Open Mind" by Fr. Thomas Keating, OCSO is a good introduction. The first Monday of each month we listen to an introduction to centering prayer and then pray for 20 minutes. Otherwise, we typically sit and pray for two 20-minute sessions with a short meditative walk in between.

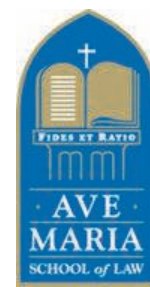

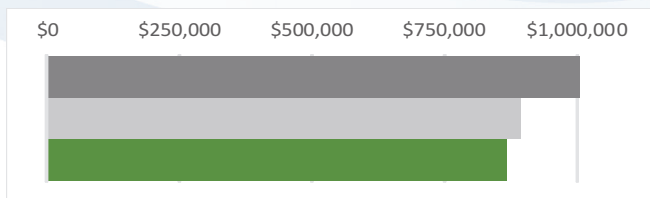

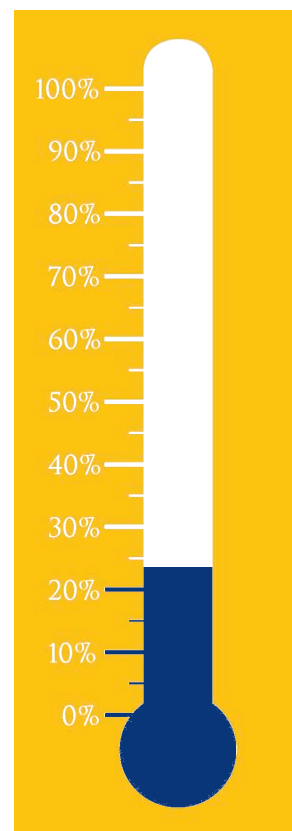
