The Alternative Spring Break Program at St. Mary Student Parish is truly special. It has provided countless opportunities throughout the years for students to put their faith into action. However, this program would truly not be possible without the constant support from St. Mary parishioners. A big thank you to all of the St. Mary's parishioners who helped support this year's Alternative Spring Break trips!

We have been able to help countless people throughout the country and world, but we have also been able to grow in our faith. All three of our trips were safe, faith-filled, and successful thanks to your generous donations. We could not have done it without your prayers and encouragement.

Our students were able to work on home repair projects, learn about different environmental issues surrounding the Appalachian community, and practice living simply and sustainably at Nazareth Farm, West Virginia. In Selma, Alabama we had students working with kids in an afterschool program, serving hot meals at the Bosco Nutrition Center, and learning more about the history of racism in the South. Students in El Salvador met with local youth groups, heard from numerous innovative organizations, learned about Salvadoran Martyrs like St. Oscar Romero, lived in solidarity with people in the community of Guarjila, and even got to try their hand at making tortillas.

Not only did we get to travel to new cities, but we were able to experience God's people in a different context and find new ways to put our faith into action. This opportunity was truly life changing and an incredible opportunity for all the participants and would not have been possible without the support of the St. Mary's parishioners.
