

"The Resurrection did more than conquer death; it made way for us to receive God's Spirit and truly walk and talk and act and breathe as God's children—the people of God.

During a time of much death, as with this pandemic, it is right for us to look toward our own resurrection rather than to fear dying. It is right to sorrow as we watch people die and to comfort them as they die, while believing that death is not the end for them.

But I believe that living the Resurrection in these days means that we embrace, nurture, and allow God to activate within us the Holy Spirit, so that we live as healers, truth-tellers, reconcilers, comforters, thinkers, and doers. May this time that seems so opposed to resurrection be shot through with our love, courage, strength, resilience, kindness, and the peace that passes human understanding.

God will show us what to do. The Spirit within will compel us toward the best thoughts, words, and actions. And we have the power to follow those promptings and fulfill God's dreams for this world, in every time and place. That's what it means to live the Resurrection."


GRADUATION MASS & RECEPTION

MEALS FOR THE HOMELESS AT MERCY HOUSE

Mercy House, located at 805 W. Huron Street in Ann Arbor, is an oasis of hope for people experiencing homelessness, providing meals, showers, clothing and personal care items. We are looking for individuals who could prepare and drop off a meal for 25-30 people on Mondays or Wednesdays, with a 5:45pm drop-off at the house. Typically, one person provides the main dish, and another provides sides and dessert, but some do both. 13 x 9 aluminum pans work best, as they do not need to be returned and will be reused by the community. (Also accepted are grocery gift cards, in any amount, to buy the ingredients to prepare a meal.)

The Maternity ward where mothers are admitted is a 10-bed ward. It accommodates all mothers who are pregnant and non-pregnant. Because of lack of infrastructure we also host in the



post Caesarean section mother as well as post normal delivery. This has been an open space ward without privacy.

The women's privacy was always compromised but now the donation helped us to have curtains that provide some privacy for mother and their babies The Nursing officer Sr Magdalen very happy preparing for mothers.

Right now, all women feel good because the ward has changed. The staff are very grateful



because they can do their nursing procedures on bed side assured of privacy for the mothers and babies. The facility is growing and knowing that the sisters will stay on site to offer care to the patients there is a community close by and the convent was renovated and the need that was pressing was the presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. 
