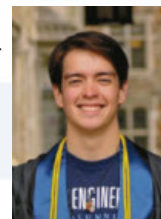

MORE THOUGHTS FROM THE SAINT HIMSELF:

Meeting people where they are

"Be ready to listen for long periods, and until each has had his say... Whenever we wish to win someone over and engage him in the greater service of God our Lord, we should use the same strategy for good which the enemy employs to draw a good soul to evil. He enters through the other's door and comes out his own. He enters with the other by not opposing his ways but by praising them. He acts familiarly with the soul, suggesting good and holy thoughts which bring peace to the good soul.

So we with a good purpose can praise or agree with another concerning some particular good thing, dissembling whatever else may be wrong. After thus gaining his confidence, we shall have better success. In this sense we go in with him his way, but come out our own."

Note: This is taken from a letter that St. Ignatius wrote in 1541 to two of the Pope's legates in Ireland.

WHAT ARE YOU SEEKING? CAN RCIA HELP?

Deep in our hearts, we have a longing to be closer to God, to feel that we have a home with him for all eternity. St. Augustine reminds us, "Our hearts are restless until they find rest in you."

The RCIA journey at St. Mary Student Parish is designed to help people hear and respond to God's loving call – and especially to his invitation for a deeper relationship with him in the tradition of the Catholic faith. The weekly sessions are designed for:

- ✚ Those who want to be baptized in the Catholic faith.
- ✚ Those who want to join the Catholic Church from another faith or another Christian tradition.
- ✚ Baptized Catholics who wish to receive the sacrament of Confirmation.

Throughout the year, participants in RCIA (the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults) are welcome to explore and ask questions as they discern where God may be leading them.

RCIA sessions will begin formally in September, but inquirers are welcome to come in anytime to talk. There's no pressure or obligation, we are happy to meet with you personally to discuss where you are in this faith journey and what God might be calling you to explore.

Mercy House, located at 805 W. Huron Street in Ann Arbor, is an oasis of hope for people experiencing homelessness, providing meals, showers, clothing and personal care items. We are looking for individuals who could prepare and drop off a meal for 25-30 people on Mondays or Wednesdays, with a 5:45pm drop-off at the house. Typically, one person provides the main dish, and another provides sides and dessert, but some do both. 13 x 9 aluminum pans work best, as they do not need to be returned and will be reused by the community. (Also accepted are grocery gift cards, in any amount, to buy the ingredients to prepare a meal.)

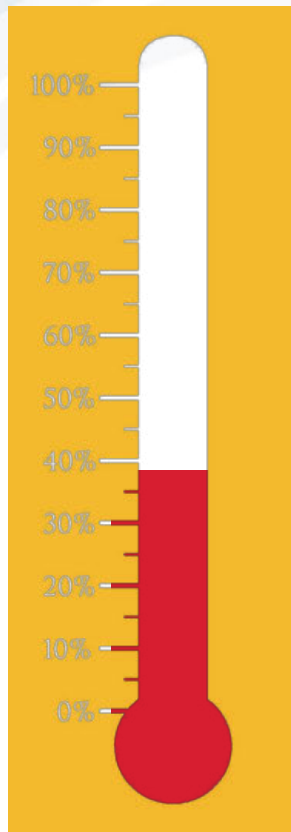

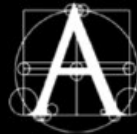
