I was taken by the words that the father of one of the newlyweds shared with me. He said that even though Jill and Bryan both come from states quite a distance away, the families all had to come to Ann Arbor because of how important it was to the couple to be married here. It's where their life is, and, they emphasized, it's where their church is. Dad was deeply pleased and proud to know how closely connected to their parish they've become.




