We attend an incredible, busy, and extremely demanding University. The first few days, weeks, and months of our

experience here at Michigan challenge us: who are we? What community will we find? Do we have the strength to uphold our values? Our minds run with a constant list of things to do, we walk around sleep deprived, and we find the devil trying to shake our faith.

My freshman year I was searching for

Jesus, thirsting for His help and comfort. I prayed that He would give me the faith to let go and let Him work in my new life at the university. Almost mid-way through the year, I got an invitation from our campus minister to consider applying to be a student leader at SMSP. Perhaps this was the opportunity that Jesus was giving me to grow closer to Him. After prayer and consideration, I sent in my student leader application. Just a couple weeks after, I accepted my offer to become a member of the outreach team at St. Mary's. Although there are many ministry lead teams that our student leaders serve on, I felt that outreach was a great fit for me. St. Mary's was beginning to feel less like a study space and more like a home.

After nearly two years serving on SMSP's outreach team, I have seen a drastic change in my relationships at the parish. The staff quickly morphed

into a solid support team who truly had an interest in my life and my faith. Student leadership days introduced me to other student leaders who became both friends and inspiration. And as for my faith, I started to see major gains in my relationship with God and my personal definition of who I am as a daughter of the King. I was beginning to see the Lord more clearly in our community at St. Mary's.

Being a student leader has challenged me to grow in my faith and to learn from my fellow student leaders. I truly believe God called me to my student leadership position to teach me specific things that I personally needed to hear. Through these past two years I have learned how to step back from the strong grip of the University and see Jesus in the little things: smiles, flowers, hugs, words, and overfed fat Michigan squirrels.

God called me to be a student leader, to grow in my faith within the comfort of a strong, caring, loving, and Christ-filled student community. Where is God calling you? Is he calling you to serve with one of our ministries? Pray. Listen. Discern. Come and join us, we would love to share our journey of faith with you, to walk with you, to learn from you, and to love you as our sibling in Christ.
