

GUEST PASTORAL PERSPECTIVE

When I accepted the position of confirmation intern for this school year, I knew there would be tests and challenges along the way. What I didn't expect was the way the tests showed up at my door.

It was a summer afternoon the week prior to school starting. I had just returned from a retreat at the Newman Center when I heard a knock at the door. My housemate popped his head out of his room to see who was at the door as I opened it to find two middle-aged men.

"Hi!" one man introduced himself, "I'm Peter... and this is Paul. And we're here from a local church to talk to you about Jesus Christ!"

My roommate's head quickly disappeared into his room. I introduced myself, and explain that I both attended a Catholic church regularly, and was also involved in teaching a class for eighth-grade students.

"Oh," they said disapprovingly on their way out. "Well if you're interested... at our church, you don't need to go to classes to go to heaven."

Throughout the year, our weekly Sunday sessions have emphasized what confirmation is, and what it is not. Many people have misconceptions about confirmation; they may think it's a coming-of-age ritual, or even a class that Catholics need to get to heaven. But it isn't either of these. Confirmation confers the gifts of the Holy Spirit on those receiving the sacrament, but also asks for a commitment to the church and to God.

As our eighth-grade students prepared for confirmation, I witnessed their tremendous personal and spiritual growth. From Eucharistic Adoration to asking their catechists theological questions, I saw the drive in these students to have a deeper connection with God. They want to learn and participate in what God has to offer.

As our confirmation candidates move forward and become more involved in activities around the church, the Holy Spirit will guide them. They will be the next generation of disciples, spreading the faith to others and taking care of all of God's children. The missionaries from that local church misunderstood the purpose of confirmation. It is a gift for the individual and the community, an outpouring of grace that is shared with others. And, having seen the love these students have for God and one another, I am confident they will fulfill the confirmation commitment.
