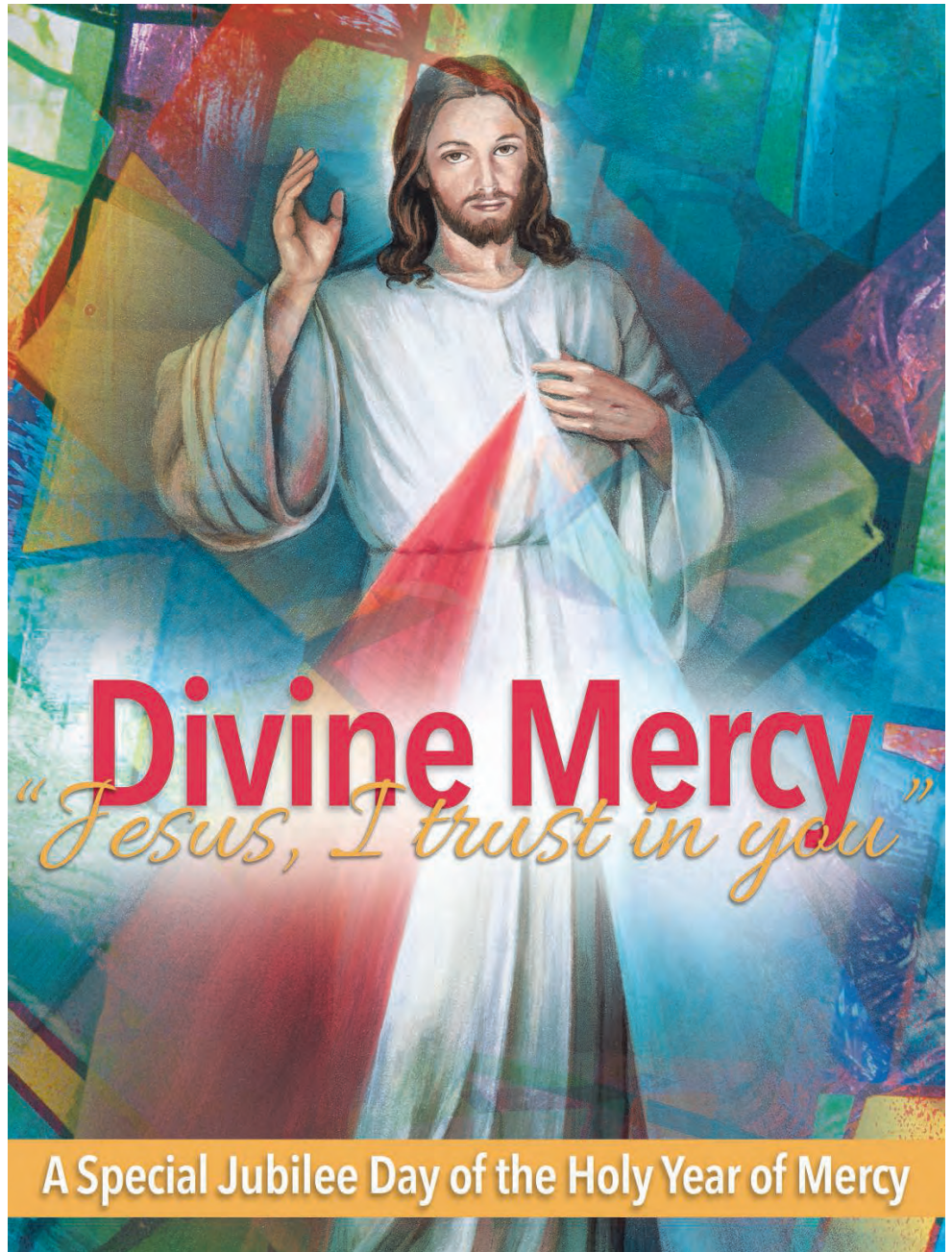

Called to new life in the Spirit

Guest Pastoral Perspective by Rita Zyber

During this season of Easter joy, we would like to congratulate and welcome our newest members of the Catholic Church who completed the sacraments of initiation last Saturday at the Easter Vigil Mass. (Please see the list at right).

Since September, they have been on a path of learning and spiritual growth through RCIA, the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults.

During Holy Week, we studied the Gospel account of Jesus raising Lazarus to new life (John 11:3–45). Fr. Eric shared a guided meditation and together we reflected on what it means to “be raised to new life.”

As Jesus urges all of us to “come forth,” what does this new life look like for each of us? How does it change the way we respond in love to all that God has done for us? What do we do with this Easter mystery?

At the Easter Vigil, as seven people were baptized and a total of 30 were confirmed in the Catholic faith, we witnessed the joy that Christ’s life-giving power is bringing to this group.

Many of the RCIA candidates expressed to us that they feel transformed because of their greater awareness of God’s love and mercy and his active presence in their lives. For me, assisting in their faith journey is a great boost to my own awareness. Together, we strive to “pay attention” to the wondrous works of God. We strive to find God in everything – even the mundane, everyday parts of life.

The text for the initiation rites often focuses on “rebirth” for those preparing for baptism, as well as those feeling called to conversion. The prayer for Holy Saturday (before the Vigil Mass) includes this wording:

Father, through your holy prophets you proclaimed to all who draw near you, “Wash and be cleansed,” and through Christ you have granted us rebirth in the Spirit.

This Easter season, may we all continue to pay closer attention – to see and respond with gratitude to all the ways in which God is present in our world. May the Holy Spirit help us to remember that each day we are given the opportunity to draw near to Christ, and when we do that, we are always granted rebirth in the Spirit.

Centering Prayer is a method of silent, contemplative prayer in which thoughts and feelings are stilled as we simply seek to be with God. It is rooted in centuries-old monastic prayer. The book *Open Heart, Open Mind* by Fr. Thomas Keating, OCSO is a good introduction. All are welcome. The first Monday of each month is a special introductory session, during which we listen to an audio tape that describes the method of Centering Prayer session. Otherwise, we typically sit for two 20-minute silent prayer sessions with a short meditative walk in between.
