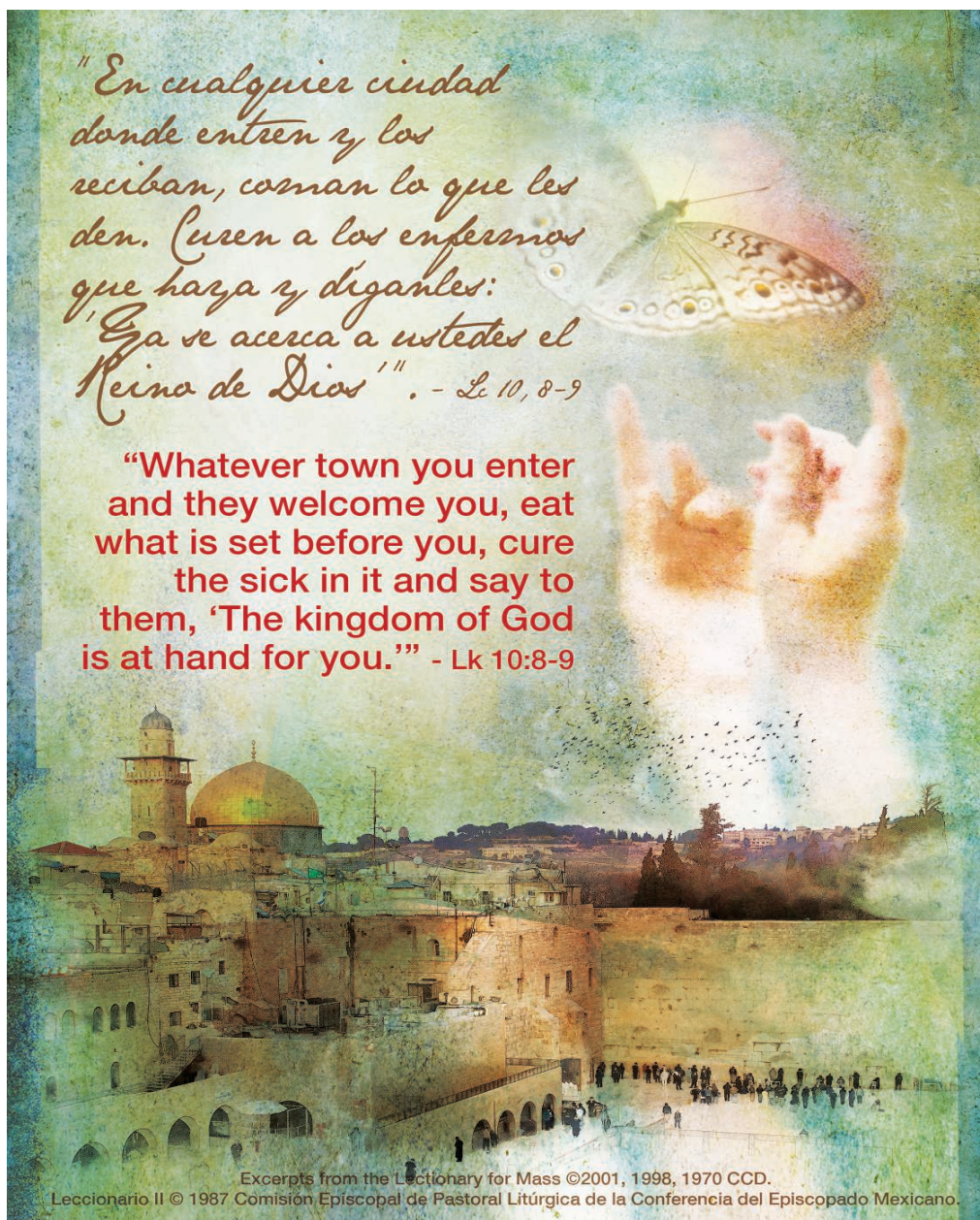

# Live By the Spirit

While preparing to write this guest pastoral perspective, I was particularly struck by the second reading for June 26: Galatians 5:1, 13-18. As we approach the 4<sup>th</sup> of July, I felt hung up on this idea of freedom. Today, people live in the headlong pursuit of freedom, which they think is doing whatever they want to do, and never denying any desire. And while this is a kind of liberty, it is not *the* liberty.

*The* liberty is our freedom from the tyranny of having to earn our own way to God. It is the freedom from sin and guilt and condemnation. It is freedom from the penalty and the power, and eventually freedom from the presence of sin.

We don't make ourselves free. Freedom is a gift of Jesus, given to us and received by faith. When we struggle to free ourselves, we just become more entangled with a yoke of bondage.

Knowing we are free in Christ, how do we live? Do others see us as a people of freedom and liberty? Often, Christians are seen as people more bound up and hung up than anybody else.

Thankfully Paul doesn't leave us hanging and instead gives us some tips to help us on our journey. First, he is clear that we should not use the liberty for our own personal gain. Second, we need to serve one another through love. These seem straightforward enough, although I for one am thankful for the reminder.

Lastly, he calls us to live by the Spirit. The Holy Spirit influences us in three distinct ways: through the message of the Bible, through others who live by the Spirit, and through an inner direction that we become more sensitive to, and respond to better, as we mature in Jesus. The final implication being if we live by the Spirit, then the Holy Spirit actually *lives* in each of us!

But living by the spirit doesn't always come easily. Often, it is a battle. And that's okay. The battle makes us realize that it takes effort to live by the Spirit. God just doesn't knock us over the head with it, and block out the things that hinder living by the Spirit. We have to seek it.

Imagine you are a computer, built with two drives. One is programmed according to the Spirit, and the other according to the flesh. In any given situation, it's up to you to decide which drive you will access. The resources of both are there – but which will you access?
