WELCOMING OUR NEW MUSIC DIRECTOR

I am honored to join the Saint Mary Student Parish staff as Music Coordinator. I look forward to continuing the rich tradition of music in our community, and I hope to meet many of you this fall.

In 2021, my wife, daughter, and I moved to Ann Arbor from Pullman, Washington where I taught at the Washington State University School of Music. You may have seen my daughter dancing to the music during the 10:00 AM Mass while I am playing guitar! This spring we welcomed our son who was baptized by Fr. Bobby in June.

Although my family and I have been parishioners at Saint Mary Student Parish for only a short time, we already feel so welcomed in the community. Since most of our extended family lives in New York State, we are truly blessed to have found a spiritual home here.

Currently, I am pursuing a Doctor of Musical Arts in Jazz and Contemporary Improvisation at the University of Michigan School of Music Theatre and Dance. My research focuses on culturally responsive jazz pedagogy. Last summer, I had the opportunity to work with the Sinti community in Germany to learn about their jazz traditions. In addition to my research, I also teach as a Graduate Student Instructor in the Music Theory Department.

From 2016 – 2019, I served as the Music Director at All Saints Parish in Corning, New York. In this position I directed and

rehearsed choirs, led music at Masses, and hosted praise and worship events. The volunteers I worked with at All Saints Parish who selflessly dedicated their time and talent continue to inspire my own vocation to ministry.

In my first months working as Music Coordinator at St. Mary Student Parish, I have similarly been inspired by the passion and dedication of our staff, music directors, and volunteers. I will be working with them closely to learn more about how I can support our wonderfully diverse community. I hope to build on the traditions established at each Mass, to offer a wide range of musical styles that reflect the interests of our community.

Currently, we are seeking to recruit additional vocalists and instrumentalists to lead music at weekend Masses and Ig.Nite on Thursdays. We perform repertoire ranging from hymns to contemporary praise and worship music. Our Mass in Spanish includes music from a variety of Latin American and Spanish music traditions. 
