### Pertussis (Whooping Cough) Alert

Someone in attendance at St. Mary on 9/29 has been recently diagnosed with a case of pertussis. Pertussis is a highly contagious disease that can be severe, particularly in young children. Pertussis can spread easily among susceptible household members and in group settings such as schools, childcare centers, workplaces, and sports teams. Adolescents and adults are also at risk for infection with the disease since vaccine protection decreases over time.
