Parish Insight

My Visit to Our Lady of Managag

My only visit to the Our Lady of Manaoag Church in Manaoag, Pangasinan in Northern Philippines in 1998 was out of curiosity, not as a devotee. The shrine is now called Minor Basilica of the Most Holy Rosary of Manaoag after Pope Francis raised its status via his decree Spiritualem Fidelium Progressium on October 11, 2014. It is an affiliate of the Papal Basilica of Santa Maria Maggiore in Rome.

When I was growing up in our hometown Tagudin, Ilocos Sur, also in Northern Philippines a maternal grandaunt regularly went to Manaoag to attend Mass, leaving at dawn and returning after lunch. I never asked why she went to Manaoag to attend Mass there when we have our town church, St. Augustine Church, founded by the Augustinians in 1568.

Years later, our neighbor-friends, home on vacation from Maui, Hawaii, never failed to go to Manaoag to attend Mass. They, too, had to leave at dawn. After Mass, they would proceed to Dagupan City, Pangasinan, center of the bangus [milkfish (Chanos chanos)] culture industry in the Philippines, to buy the ubiquitous "boneless" bangus. In our town, going to Manaoag is synonymous to attending Mass at the Our Lady of Manaoag Church.

My curiosity was aroused so I asked our 81-year-old mother if she had been to Manaoag. She said "no" and recalled my grandaunt (her mother's younger sister named after Santa Monica, the old name of Manaoag) going to Manaoag, as a vow.

She readily agreed to go to Manaoag. One morning, my mother and I along with her three-year- old granddaughter boarded a bus headed for Manila since Pangasinan is on the bus route. We told the bus conductor that we would like to attend Mass in Manaoag. He gave us instructions on how to get there since Manaoag is not on their route.

Alongside the Our Lady of Manaoag Church were vendors of statues and images of saints and other souvenirs and herbalists selling leaves, barks and roots of plants and coconut oil prepared on Good Friday, believed to cure all sorts of ailments.

The church facade was simple and unassuming. We missed the morning masses. There were few people inside, kneeling and praying. We knelt, prayed and thanked Our Lady of Manaoag

for the opportunity to come and venerate her.

We were awed and mesmerized as we looked inside the church and admired the statue of Our Lady of Manaoag on the high altar with her resplendent crown and elaborate vestment. Solemnity, joy, and peace overcame us.

We took pictures of Our Lady of Manaoag and of ourselves. At the churchyard were cars waiting to be blessed. It is a tradition among the Catholics in the Philippines to have their homes, cars, and religious articles blessed.

We went home, feeling blessed and fulfilled.
