Parish Insight

SERVING IN HONDURAS WITH INTERNATIONAL SAMARITAN

Earlier this summer, I had the incredible opportunity to travel to Honduras with a small group from St. Mary's Parish in partnership with International Samaritan. International Samaritan is a nonprofit organization that works to break the cycle of poverty for families living in communities surrounding garbage dumps across Central America. Their mission focuses on providing education, health care, and dignity to those living and working in some of the most marginalized environments.

Throughout the week, we participated in a variety of service projects and community experiences. One of the most meaningful parts of the trip was the time we spent with the children. We played games, laughed, and built genuine connections that transcended language. Their joy and energy were contagious, and our group quickly felt like a part of their family.

We helped with several hands-on projects at the Family Life Center, including painting benches and gates, and filling potholes to improve safety around the area. We were glad to contribute to making the space more welcoming and functional for the community.

One of the most powerful experiences of the trip was preparing and delivering meals to people who work in the garbage dump. We also distributed food baskets to families living in the nearby communities. It was both eye-opening and humbling to see the conditions in which these individuals live and work every day. Yet, despite the hardships, we were met with

overwhelming gratitude and warmth. We were always greeted with a smile and love.

Toward the end of the trip, we had the opportunity to explore some surrounding towns and learn more about the local culture and history. A highlight was a pizza party we shared with several scholars. Hearing their dreams and stories was inspiring, they are so driven.

This trip reminded me that service is not just about what you give, but also what you receive. I returned home with a renewed sense of gratitude, community, and faith. There are not enough words to describe the rollercoaster of emotions experienced on this trip, to say the least, this was an emotionally challenging experience. You wanted to cry and laugh all at the same time. I met the happiest of people with nothing to give but overflowing love, that feels like all you need in life. I felt a sense of community on a different level than I have ever experienced. I truly felt like I walked hand in hand with the children of God. There is absolutely nothing in a lifetime that could bring this type of fulfillment into a heart. I received immensely more than I could have given to this community.

Thank you to everyone at St. Mary Parish who supported and prayed for us. Your encouragement made this experience possible, and I hope it inspires others to step out in faith and serve in whatever way they can.





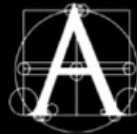
