AN UPDATE FROM A NOVICE

It's been just over a year since I left Ann Arbor, and I often think back with gratitude to my time at St. Mary. It was there that I first began to hear God's call more clearly — not just to religious life, but to a deeper relationship with Him.

But for some reason, I thought that when I entered religious life, my relationship with God would reach a certain steady-state: "I've decided to join the Jesuits; thank goodness I don't have to think about what I'm going to do with my life anymore!"

I think I was relieved that people weren't asking me what I was going to do when I graduated, which is an anxiety-inducing question for college students. But in the past year, I've come to appreciate more that a vocation is a daily "yes," not just a one-time decision. No matter what stage of life we're at, God is always drawing us deeper into His divine life.

This lesson became clear on my pilgrimage — a time of the novitiate where the novice gets \$30 and a one-way bus ticket and lives on the road through the generosity of those strangers he encounters along the way.

I spent the month in Denver, and stayed at the home of a guy I met on the first day I arrived, at the Mother Cabrini Shrine, with Capuchin friars, and with missionaries. The people of Denver were incredibly generous; I had more than enough of everything — so much that I gave away hundreds of dollars that had been given to me. It was the best month of my life. God is so generous!

On the last day, in Eucharistic adoration, I was overwhelmed with gratitude, and as I expressed that to God, I sensed His reply: *"It only gets better from here!"*

That's true for all of us. Whether student, parent, or retiree, God is not finished loving us. He invites us to say "yes" again today by loving the people in front of us - especially the poor - and to trust that He is leading us deeper into His life.

As today's Gospel reminds us, that's not easy. The "getting better" of deepening our relationship with God will sometimes mean experiencing some growing pains. Still, we are invited to persevere: *"By your perseverance you will secure your lives."* (Luke 21:19)

Thank you for being a community that helped me say "yes."
