Parish Insight

“AM I NOT HERE, I WHO AM YOUR MOTHER?”

December 12th is an important date for Catholics in Mexico, as it is the day we celebrate the Virgin of Guadalupe. In Tijuana, as in the rest of Mexico, pilgrimages take place in the days leading up to December 12th, and one of the most prominent in the city is the one that takes place on the night of December 11th along Independencia Street, better known as 9th Street, towards the Shrine of the Virgin of Guadalupe (the old cathedral).

As children, my parents would take my sisters and me to see the pilgrimage, in which dancers and people participate with a reenactment of the apparition of the Virgin of Guadalupe to Saint Juan Diego on decorated trucks. At that time, the pilgrimage seemed like a very beautiful celebration, but when I learned more about our Catholic faith, I realized the importance of the celebration, which also gives us an identity as Mexican Catholics and makes me feel proud of our roots. When I first attended Mass in Spanish at St Mary's, seeing the image of Our Lady of Guadalupe next to the altar made me feel at home, but my biggest surprise was that devotion to the Virgin is not only part of the Mexican community, but also of the whole Latin community.

Last November, I was invited to participate as Saint Juan Diego in the reenactment of the Virgin's apparition, which I gladly accepted. Developing the role of a character in a reenactment has always been a challenge for me, but playing the role of Saint Juan Diego was very special because he is a saint representative of Mexico.

During rehearsals, I wondered what Saint Juan Diego's encounter with Our Lady of Guadalupe must have been like. Did he feel fear at first? Did he feel peace in the presence of our Blessed Mother? I also thought about the sadness he must have felt when they didn't believe him when he took the message to the bishop, or the joy at his sick uncle's recovery.

Everything that Saint Juan Diego must have gone through back then, I have felt at some point in my life, and just as he trusted in our Blessed Mother, I too entrust myself to her guidance, but above all to her protection, which fills me with strength and hope to keep going. That is why I tell the immigrant community that we must not forget what Our Lady of Guadalupe said to Saint Juan Diego: “Am I not here, I who am your mother?” Words that remind us that she is always with us to offer her help and protection as a true Mother.

CAPITAL CAMPAIGN UPDATE

We are so grateful to all of you who have supported our combined Capital Campaign. The following is a brief update and explanation of the next steps. As of November 21, 2025, St. Mary has \$4,262,628 in total gifts and pledges, surpassing our campaign goal of \$4.25 million, thanks to your incredible generosity. Of this total, we have already received more than \$1.7 million in donations, which means that we have more than fulfilled our \$1.1 million parish goal for the Catholic education portion of the Stewardship for Saints and Scholars (S3) campaign.

The Catholic Foundation collects these gifts and on a quarterly basis transfers funds into a St. Mary account. Since we have met our S3 goal for the Catholic education portion of the combined campaign, 100% of gifts collected from now onward will go into this St. Mary account. With these initial funds, we will be able to move forward with the planning and design of our various facilities maintenance and upgrade projects.

Strategic committees, which include staff as well as resident and student parishioners, have been established to put plans together of how and when to use these funds. We would appreciate your prayers and look forward to providing more updates in the near future. Thank you.

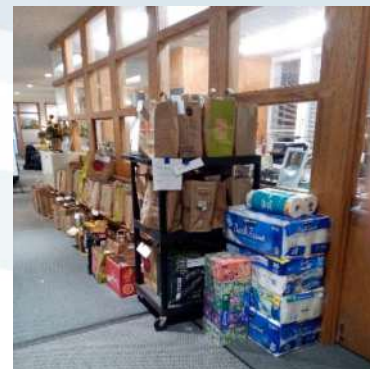

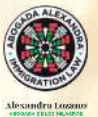
