Parish Insight

Grad/YP Retreat 2026: “Discerning God’s Will in Daily Life”

From January 23rd to 25th the Graduate Student and Young Professional (Grad/YP) group held our annual retreat at Manresa Jesuit Retreat House in Bloomfield Hills. About 45 Grad/YPs ventured out in the frigid cold to participate in a variety of activities including talks, small group sharing, individual prayer time, and plenty of fellowship.

As young adults, many of us are grappling with major life decisions, such as new jobs or relationships. We also feel the push and pull of daily decisions, such as how we spend our time, grow our faith, and support our friends. Because we seek to follow Christ, we want to root our decision-making in our relationship with Him. This inspired our Lead Team, along with Fr. Dan, to focus our retreat on the theme “Discerning God’s Will in Daily Life.”

Throughout the weekend we had four talks on this theme. Fr. Dan provided spiritual grounding through one talk on Ignatian Discernment of Spirits and another on Discerning in Daily Life. Grad/YP Lead Team members Sebastian Abisleiman and Mary Gass provided testimonials to help relate discernment to our lives. These talks prompted rich discussion in our small group sharing and inspired fruitful prayer time in Manresa’s beautiful Chapel.

Retreatants enjoyed many opportunities for prayer. These included both individual opportunities such as Adoration as well as group opportunities including a Rosary, Divine Mercy Chaplet, Vespers, and Compline – all led by members of our community. Retreatants also had some fun! In our free-time we played board games, frolicked in the snow, caught up in conversation, ate too many snacks, and played Wordle on white boards. Some of us also played Sardines in the wee hours of the night (unfortunately for those trying to sleep!). We had great fun and appreciated the opportunity to bond with old friends and cultivate new ones.

While welcoming us to the Retreat House, Sister Linda described Manresa as “a place where the veil between God and Earth

seems a bit thinner.” This resonated with many of our retreatants, evidenced by the number of times it was referenced throughout our conversations! This weekend was a much needed time to step back from our busy-ness and reflect on how God is speaking to us. Manresa helped make this possible. Described by our retreatants as “beautiful” and “peaceful,” Manresa was a wonderful setting to have our retreat. We highly recommend it!

Overall, our Grad/YP community had another wonderful retreat. We are especially grateful for the time with each other, our time with Fr. Dan (while we still have him!), and most importantly, our time with the Lord.

May God continue to bless our graduate students and young professionals with the grace to discern His presence and guidance in their daily lives, rooting each choice more deeply in Christ.

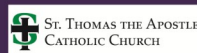
