Parish Insight

"Think of me as a graduating senior," I told the students at an 8pm Mass in January, when I announced this would be my last semester serving at St. Mary. Goodbyes are never easy: they can feel so final, and even awkward. I have found myself wondering over the past few weeks, "Am I going to see this person again? Have I said what I needed to say? Do they know how much I appreciate them, how proud I am of how they've grown, how moved I am at the depth of their faith?"

For me, the most challenging part of Jesuit life is the tug on my heart every time I am called to a new mission. I feel in my bones the pull that the place, and the relationships I have formed, have made on me. I have been reflecting upon the advice I once received from my superior in New York: "The fundamental asceticism of Jesuit life is the comings and goings," he wrote. Jesuit life is itinerant, as St. Ignatius wanted us to be able to respond when called upon to a new mission. This availability for mission comes with a cost—you may be called upon to leave a community that you love.

But the sadness I feel in leaving Ann Arbor and this faith-filled community at St. Mary has been oddly consoling: it's a sign that something is working. You have helped to form me as a priest through your encouragement, your kindness, and the sincerity with which you have shared your faith with me. It has such a privilege to share your joys and sorrows through sacraments, spiritual conversation, and prayer. You have helped me to see that serving as a priest is a precious gift, the path that God is calling me to grow in love of God and neighbor. Of the many graces I have received over these three years, this is the most significant. Thank you.

Compared to a "goodbye," I've found that framing this transition as a graduation of sorts has been helpful. I can acknowledge that something is changing— that there is a loss in leaving that needs to be named, perhaps even grieved. But, just as our graduates are doing this weekend, I can also acknowledge how good it has been to grow in our faith these last three years as we opened the Scriptures and broke bread together. As our Centennial celebration reminded us, there is no place quite like St. Mary's: our unique blend of students and residents, vibrant English-speaking and Spanish-speaking communities, young families and pa-

rishioners who have worshipped here for over 50 years. Our community remains united in Christ even with these differences, and that is such an important sign in our polarized world.

Much like our graduates, I know that God is leading me to something exciting and new. Serving as the president of University of Detroit Jesuit High School and Academy will require all the time, attention, and care that I can offer. Still, I consider it a blessing and a gift from God that I am not moving far, but back home to serve a community that formed my dad, my brothers and me. I am happy to stay in touch, and the best way is via email: ddixon@jesuits.org. Please pray for me during this time of transition, and know that I am praying for you. May God bless you, and all of St. Mary Student Parish, and may you glorify God by the way you live your lives!

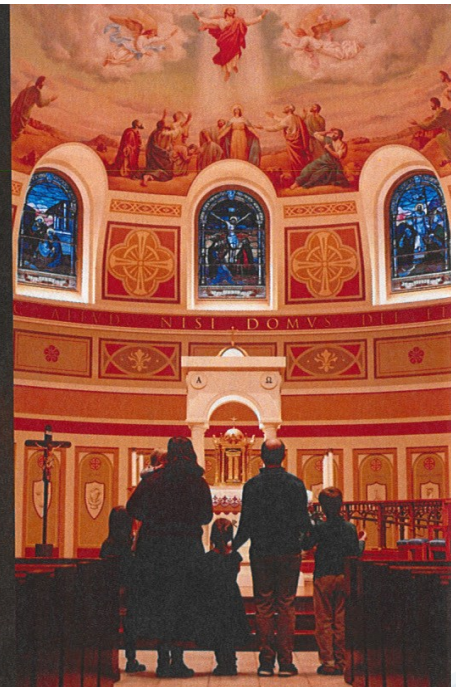

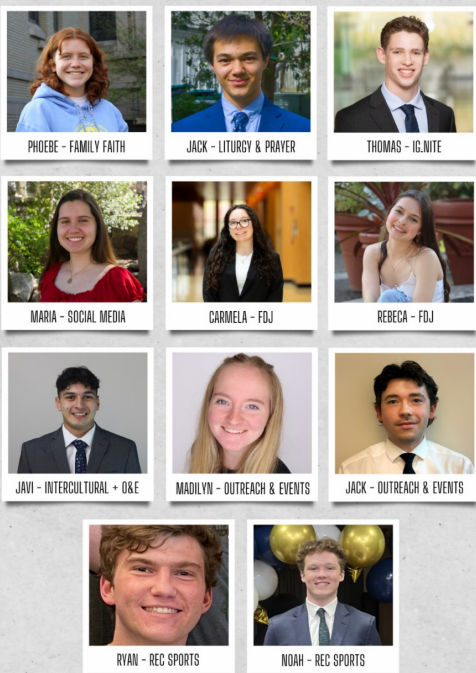

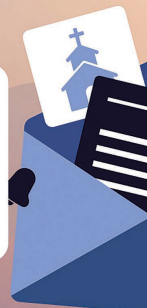
