Parish Insight

SERVING WITH INTERNATIONAL SAMARITAN

“Inspired by Ignatian spirituality, we live a faith that does justice, reaching out to the marginalized.”

(excerpt from St. Mary’s Student Parish Mission Statement)

In May, for the fourth consecutive year, a group of St. Mary’s parishioners joined International Samaritan on a mission to encounter and serve housing- and food-insecure children and families. We joined the community in the hills of Tegucigalpa, Honduras, bordering a massive regional garbage dump, where the primary local economic activity is foraging in the dangerous dump for food and materials of value. The community is aided greatly by the Buen Samaritano Family Center, constructed last year by International Samaritan as a safe, welcoming place for scholars and their families – to cook, use the bathroom, play on the playground, use computers, take English classes, and simply meet to connect and support one another.

Our activities included meaningful experiences working arm-in-arm with the community members:

- Built an indoor latrine for a scholar, her 3 siblings and their mother
- Prepared 200 meals and traveled into the garbage dump to serve the working men and women
- Painted the playground walls (used for “football”, basketball, portable pools, and many local events)
- Decorated the facility for Mother’s Day, and honored the sacrifice and love of local mothers with a meal and recognition
- Attended mass at Basilica of Our Lady of Suyapa, visited El Cristo de Picacho statue, and shared a special lunch experience with young scholars.

Every moment of the trip profoundly impacted our heads and our hearts (and even our muscles), but I’d highlight three reflections from our experience:

- While conditions in the community are very difficult, and the future remains challenging, scholars and their families consistently find and express joy – Joy is seen throughout the day, simply in being together, in sharing moments of humor or happiness or prayer, in small achievements and experiences. Joy is not a function of

accumulation or scorekeeping or winning, but in making someone feel valued or heard or included. This manifestation of joy was a great example to us.

- The trip provided an incredible canvas for spiritual growth - We began each day in prayer, and concluded each evening in prayer and reflection, and discussed teachings from Pope Leo, Fr. Ted Hesburgh, Cesar Romero, Pope John Paul II and more. We were strengthened by the experience, and by the prayerful sharing from each of the trip members.

- To Encounter is to live our Faith, and is a means to building Solidarity: While we know we cannot be present in the Bueno Samaritano community on a regular basis, we have experienced their conditions, developed sincere relationships with the community, and have built a bond of solidarity. Through this shared experience, we will better advocate and support individuals not just in Honduras, but anywhere economic and social inequality is present and our fellow children of God need our love and support.

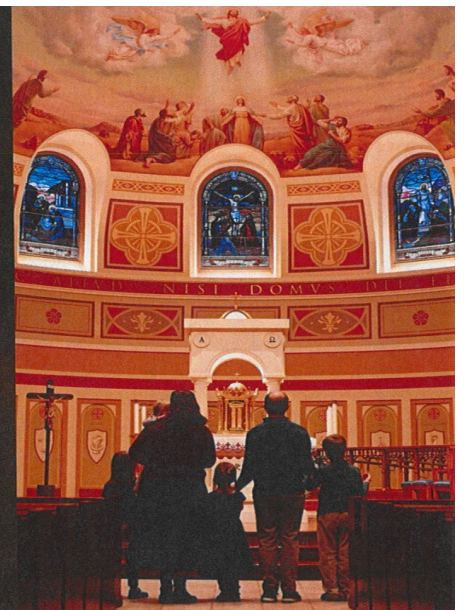

Reconciled to God through the blood of Christ, we are chosen people, “a holy nation”, the sheep of God’s flock. We are called, as were the Twelve, to go forth and bear witness to the reign of God.

June 21 - Twelfth Sunday in Ordinary Time

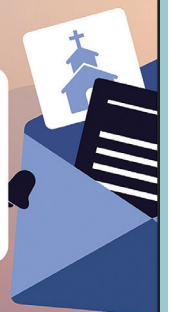
